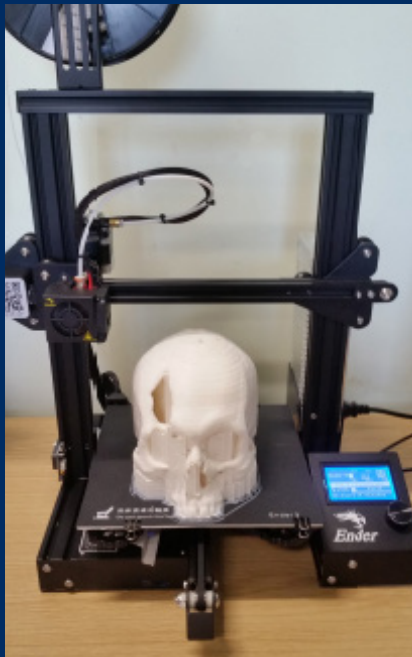


# MANUFACTURING CLUB
